The camp preparations began a day before the event when a team of professional from Sadguru Seva Sangh Trust arrived at the school to conduct training for teachers. The training session provided teachers with essential knowledge on identifying potential eye issues and understanding the basics of eye care. Teachers learned how to conduct initial assessments, such as reading eye charts and identifying signs of common vision issues.

On the day of the camp, the trained teachers conducted preliminary screenings and checkups by guiding students through the process.
